What is a General Plan?

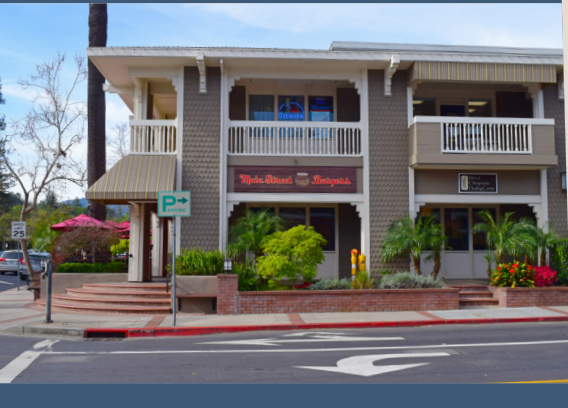
The Town of Los Gatos has begun a process to update the General Plan, which was last adopted in 2010. The General Plan is the Town's "blueprint" that guides decision making for land use, transportation, infrastructure, community design, environmental issues, and other important topics that impact the community. The General Plan is a long-range planning document that will look ahead to 2040.

Why update the current General Plan?

While the existing General Plan is serving the community well, the Town is doing an update to refine the General Plan, address emerging trends and recent changes in State law, and consider new issues. This planning effort will allow the General Plan to incorporate best practices in planning to ensure Los Gatos is resilient to future risks while also enhancing the community's quality of life.
